B. Call to the Public – Mayor

A.R.S. 38-431.01 states the Public Body may make an open call to the public during a public meeting, subject to reasonable time, place and manner restrictions, to allow individuals to address the public body on any issue within the jurisdiction of the Public Body. At the conclusion of an open call to the public, individual members of the Public Body may respond to criticism made by those who have addressed the Public Body, may ask staff to review a matter or may ask that a matter be put on a future agenda. However, members of the Public Body shall not discuss or take legal action on matters raised during an open call to the public unless the matters are properly noticed for discussion and legal action.

C. New Business Before Council - Mayor

Public comment will be taken at the beginning of each agenda item, after the subject has been announced by the Mayor and explained by staff. Any citizen, who wishes, may speak one time for five minutes on each agenda item before or after Council discussion. Questions from Council Members, however, may be directed to staff or a member of the public through the Mayor at any time.

C.1 PUBLIC HEARING [Mayor Wallace]: Public Hearing on the Town's Final Budget and Property Tax Levy for Fiscal Year 2026-2027. Members of the public may appear before the Council to comment on the Town's proposed budget and tax levy. Any anticipated revenues and expenses of the Town may be discussed.

C.2 Discussion and/or Action [Mayor Wallace]: RESOLUTION NO. 2026-11 - A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF HUACHUCA CITY, ARIZONA, ADOPTING THE FINAL BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026-2027. Any anticipated revenues and expenses of the Town may be discussed. A Roll call, unanimous vote of the Council would be required to approve this item.

C.3 Discussion and/or Action [Suzanne Harvey]: RESOLUTION NO. 2026-12 - A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF HUACHUCA CITY, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE TOWN TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH TOMBSTONE UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT # 1 FOR SHARING OF FACILITIES TO SUPPORT PUBLIC EDUCATIONAL AND RECREATIONAL PROGRAMS. This would be a renewal of the existing agreement with the school district for another three years.

C.4 Discussion and/or Action [Mayor Wallace]: Appointment of a councilmember to serve in the position of Mayor Pro Tem to fill the vacancy created by the resignation of former Mayor Pro Tem Christy Hirshberg. This appointment will be temporary until the new Mayor and Council are sworn and seated after the general election November 3, 2026. The Mayor Pro Tem performs the duties of the Mayor during the Mayor's absence or disability. The Mayor Pro Tem also assumes the office of Mayor in the event of a vacancy in that office. Town Code Section 2.10.020.
