HUACHUCA CITY TOWN COUNCIL MINUTES REGULAR MEETING AT 7:00 PM THURSDAY, JANUARY 26, 2017

- A. The Meeting was Called to Order at 7:00 p.m. and the Pledge of Allegiance was said.

Attorney Benavidez stated he didn't get the executive session minutes in time so we will remove those. Mayor Taylor moved to approve the regular minutes from January 12, 2017, seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Johnson.

 - 1. Joy Banks spoke about the fire department and workshop.
- E. Reports by Council Members and Officers:

- 1. Council Member Welsch Library/Senior Center-. Council Member Welsch reported that he will only being doing report once a month.
- Council Member Hjeldness Finance –. Council Member Hjeldness reported
 that she has been working with Clerk Mitchell and Finance Clerk Ha to see
 what our option are for making an educated decision on what Police and Fire
 needs.
- 3. Council Member Johann-Wallace-Planning and Zoning- Council Member J. Wallace reported that we have our P & Z meeting on February 1, 2017. They will be working on the sign codes and the General Plan. Council Member Wallace conveyed that he is contacting Cox Communications to see what our options are and what we as a town can do next.
- 4. Council Member Butterworth -Public Safety -Council Member Butterworth reported that the Police as of 1/21/2017 have responded to 94 calls for service, affected 48 traffic stops, issued 6 warnings and equipment repair orders with 11 separate violations, issued 34 separate charges on 22 tickets and processed 5 arrests. The Animal Control responded to 13 calls for service. The Fire Department responded to 27 EMT calls and 3 fire calls. Dispatch cleared 25 calls and answered 619 calls and greeted 266 visitors. Chief Allmon stated that they have been working on the trucks and have another one down. Right now we have been going around and finding dangerous areas that have high brush and we are cleaning this out for Fire Danger. We have been moving the fire danger back about 10 feet from houses trying to prevent fires from spreading. The Fire Department has entered an agreement with Fry Fire in case there is an emergency that we can drive the ambulance while they work on the patient.
- 5. Council Member Hirshberg-Parks and Recreation-Council Member Hirshberg reported that the Ice Cream Social will be February 17 at the Senior Center. We are always welcoming new members so let me know.
- 6. Mayor Pro Tem Johnson Public Works (PW) Mayor Pro Tem Johnson read the report presented from PW Halterman.
- 7. Mayor Mayor Taylor reported that we had a planning and goal setting meeting and it went great. Setting goal for the city and discussing budgetary items. This has taken a few years to get things together. Public is invited it will be held February 7 at 6:30 p.m.
- 8. Town Clerk/Administrator Report- Clerk Mitchell reported that she has received a letter from CDBG Block Grant and we have 240,000.00 reserved for us. The project will not be ready to go till the later part of this year. Our heating and cooling units will be delivered on Monday. Also with Fire Mitigation the old trailer park in lower has been cut and cleaned.
