<u>Changes to Trash</u> - Huachuca City will begin using Waste Management for Town trash services in December 2018. The first trash pickup by Waste Management will be on Wednesday, December 5<sup>th</sup>. All trash cans will be street-side pickup. Public works will begin picking up town-owned trash cans on December 3, 2018

<u>Sales tax</u>- Town sales tax will increase from 1.5% to 1.9% on December 1, 2018. We will continue to have the lowest sales tax in Cochise County.
