<u>Water/Sewer Rate Increases</u> – Effective April 1st, Town water and sewer rates will increase. The new rates will be reflected on your April utility bill. It was a difficult but very necessary decision to raise rates. The Town has lost over \$1.1 million on water & sewer since 2010. Police Coverage - For the first time since the early 2000s, the Huachuca City Police Department now has officers on duty 24/7, 365 days per year!

<u>Dispatch Services</u> – The Town joined Southeastern Arizona Communications Center (SEACOM) in February 2019. SEACOM has been providing emergency dispatch services since Feb 4th. The transition to SEACOM will save the Town \$120,000 annually.
