
<u>Financial Update</u> – The Town of Huachuca City has a balanced budget for FY 19-20. This is the first time the Town has had a balanced budget, with no deficit spending, since at least 2008. There is actually a small surplus of \$17K which will go back into HURF funds for future road projects.

<u>Property Tax Rate</u> – Town Council passed the FY 2019-20 Property Tax Rate of 1.33%. This is the same property tax rate as FY 18-19
