<u>Town Council Vacancy</u> - The Town of Huachuca City is accepting applications to fill the remaining term of a vacant Town Council position. To be eligible, the applicant must be a registered voter, must be a resident of Huachuca City, must be at least 18 years old and have resided within Town limits for the last 12 months.
