

## **NOTICE OF PROPOSED SALES TAX INCREASES**

The Town Council will consider increasing its Sales Tax at its meeting on September 13th, 2018, at 7:00 pm, at Town Hall located at 500 N. Gonzales Blvd, Huachuca City, AZ. Before the Council takes action on this proposal, a public hearing will be held on September 13<sup>th</sup>, 2018, at 6:45pm, at Town Hall. The increase proposals will be as follows:

Increase the Sales Tax from 1.5% to 1.9% on the following items: Advertising, Amusements, Contracting-Prime, Contractor-Speculative, Contractor-Owner, Feed at Wholesale, Job Printing, Manufactured Buildings, Timbering & Other Extractions, Publications, Hotels, Rental Occupancy, Rental Licensing & Leasing for Use of Tangible Personal Property, Restaurant & Bar, Retail Sales, Retail Sales Food for Home Consumption, MRRA, Communications, Transportation and Utilities.

- This sales tax increase would include imposing the 1.9% tax on retail sales of food for home consumption, which the Town has not previously imposed.
- With this proposal, the Council will also consider lowering its current taxes on residential and commercial rental, leasing and licensing from 1.5% to 1.0%.

If approved, this increase in sales tax would begin on December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018.

This proposed increase is authorized by A.R.S. Title 42, Chapter 6, Articles 1 and 2. Additional information concerning this proposal is also available on the homepage of the Town's website.
