

Huachuca City Landfill Fee Increases Support Data

The Town of Huachuca City, Arizona currently offers tipping fees that are lower than all of its business competitors in the area. Despite the modification of fees in 2023, they were insufficient to cover the total operational and capital expenditures for fiscal year 2023-24. The proposed rate adjustments address increased operational costs and aligns the city's rates with those of surrounding competitors.

In an effort to enhance the profitability of the Huachuca City landfill, the Town of Huachuca City is proposing to increase these fees as follows:

- Increase the commercial per ton fee from \$59.00 to \$61.00.
- Residential vehicle fee will be \$10.35 for up to 360 pounds of trash. Over 360 pounds will be charged at \$61 per ton.
- Increase the fee for dead animals-livestock from \$59.00 to \$61.00 per ton.
- Increase the charge accounts fee from \$59.00 to \$61.00 per ton.
- Increase the special commercial/business rate (minimum 2,500 tons) from \$38 to \$53 per ton.

These proposed landfill fee increases will be considered by the Huachuca City Town Council on Thursday, September 26, 2024, at 6 PM at Town Hall, located at 500 N. Gonzales Blvd, Huachuca City, AZ.

If approved, these changes will go into effect on October 1, 2024.
